BRIDGE

The PRIMO can be equipped with two bridge models, both in a wrap-around style: The Faber is a more vintage-styled, open sounding, lightweight bridge, highly resonant but not individually adjustable for intonation. The Schaller Signum, on the other hand, is a more contemporary, heavier bridge offering greater sustain, with full adjustability. Both bridges are "locking," meaning they can be secured to the body for better vibration transfer.

ELECTRONICS CONFIGURATION

By default, the PRIMO has a volume and tone control, along with a three-way selector in case of dual pickups, but you can choose the configuration you prefer.

NECK PROFILE

Each Nisio neck is hand-carved, using predefined templates for reference. For this reason, the profile choice is indicative, giving an idea of the type of neck the customer is used to. The neck will then be shaped to match the template and be as comfortable as possible.

Both profiles are inspired by what other brands call a "Medium C." The neck, in either version, is very comfortable and versatile from the first to the last fret. Regardless of this, you can still specify any particular requests in the notes:

CARBON FIBER REINFORCEMENT

Two carbon fiber rods that run the length of the neck. A well-made neck is stable in any condition, but the reinforcement adds extra insurance against thermal and environmental changes (ideal for musicians who travel a lot in varied conditions) or for those who frequently and drastically change string gauges.
